



Between /June July/


increase back to 2019 level

Comparison: yr. 2019 and yr. 2020





Changes in TD according to type of drug used

TD during lockdown

- Significant decline in TD in patients with polydrug use,
- No decline due to other drugs /cannabis, stimulants, opiods/
- No decline in OST
- telemedicine alternatives provisions

7-dňové kĺzavé priemery




Mobilita Slovákov za posledný týždeň klesla na úroveň z konca apríla

Conclusions

COVID-19 pandemic has impact on TD of problem drug users in Bratislava – decrease

Two main reasons were identified:

objective – regulation with reduction of social mobility

subjective – fear of being infected on the treatment premises

OST was not influenced

Telemedicine was helpful, but not able fully compensate personal contact with services
